

PANDA PRE-PRIMARY SCHOOL

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

All parents must obtain an admission form from the office for your child/children for admission for 2024.

The application form must be completed and returned to the office, <u>new applicants need to attach the following to</u>
their admission form: (No new applicants will be accepted without all the required documents attached)

- * Copies of both parents ID documents
- * Proof of residence
- * Copy of child's birth certificate
- * Copy of medical aid card
- * Copy of clinic card
- * One passport/ID sized photo

Once the application form has been returned, your application will be acknowledged and your child will be put on the appropriate list.

SCHOOL FEES

The school fees for the year 2024 will be **R1600.00 per m**onth (includes computer lessons on a weekly basis) for eleven months only. **New admissions need to pay a once off R300.00 registration fee.** Fees are to be paid in advance for the month ahead not for the past month. If fees are paid on the 15th it must be for the coming month.

Computer fees are included in the monthly fee. Computer classes are part of the school curriculum and it is compulsary for all children to attend!

Photographs are taken once a year and a morning outing is arranged during the year.

Panda school fees should be paid into the following account: (Please don't use the ABSA account for Panda fees)

Use your child's name and surname as reference when making payments, proof of payment must be sent to school.

Should a child stay away from school for a month or more, the fees are still due. One month's written notice should be given if a child is to leave the school. The office is open from 07:15 - 16:00.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

ALL children are expected to wear the uniform. Boys and girls wear green shorts and white t-shirt or the Panda red t-shirt. Any shoes may be worn. (Takkies are good for playing and running!) Sandals are allowed too. The tracksuit, shorts and Panda shirt are available from White River Outfitters (013 751 1589), in the Strydom Spar Centre. (The Panda - tracksuit may be worn in Grade one or until it gets too small).

FORMAL LEARNING PROGRAMME

The teachers at Panda Pre- School, first and foremost teach the children about the Lord Jesus and His saving grace. Each class begins every day with a Bible story. Praise and Worship Prayer. We also offer compulsory computer lessons which is included into the school fees. All three groups i.e. junior, intermediate and senior groups are required to complete a formal school readiness programme, each one according to their own level and age. Parents of children in the intermediate and senior groups are expected to buy a workbook. This book will not be taken home until the end of the year. The books are ordered from the school as all pupils use the same book.

Our little ones who attend Panda Pre-School are automatically accepted into Hazyview Primary School when they are ready to go to Grade One.

A SAFE, SECURE ATMOSPHERE

A child who feels safe and secure will be able to develop a positive self-image and will have confidence. Each teacher is expected to give support, encouragement and love to each child. The child is encouraged to participate in a variety of "hands on" learning activities. A classroom routine will help to create a positive and secure atmosphere in the school. Children will have the opportunity of learning basic computer skills aswell.
